Quality improvement strategies adopted by the institution:

- 1. Admission of Students: The college follows rules & regulations of APSCHE (Andhra Pradesh State Council for Higher Education)for UG admissions through OAMDC(Online Admissions Module for Degree Colleges) website. Admissions are done purely on merit basis and according to the reservation policy of the state govt.
- 2. Library, ICT and Physical Infrastructure / Instrumentation: Library is automated using SOUL software version 1.0. It is linked with INFLIBNET and all the faculty and students are given access to several E-books and E journals.
- 3. **Research and Development:** As far as the research is concerned there is very less scope because we have only UG/ PG courses in the college. Still the faculty is very much aware and actively involved in the research work.
- 4. **Examination and Evaluation:** 25 marks are evaluated by the college as Internal assessment based on attendance, mid tests and assignment for both Theory and Practical. The remaining 75 marks are evaluated by the university through theory examination at the end of each Semester'.
- 5. **Teaching and Learning:** Apart from class room Lecture method, Group discussions, field studies, seminars are used for teaching. Digital and Virtual classrooms are utilised regularly by our faculty for ICT based teaching. Peer learning is promoted in and outside the class. Study tours are organized for making learning more effective as per requirement.
- 6. **Curriculum Development:** CBCS Curriculum developed by APSCHE w.e.f 2020-21 is introduced for first year UG and affiliating university syllabus is followed for UG second year and third year for the academic year 2020-21.
