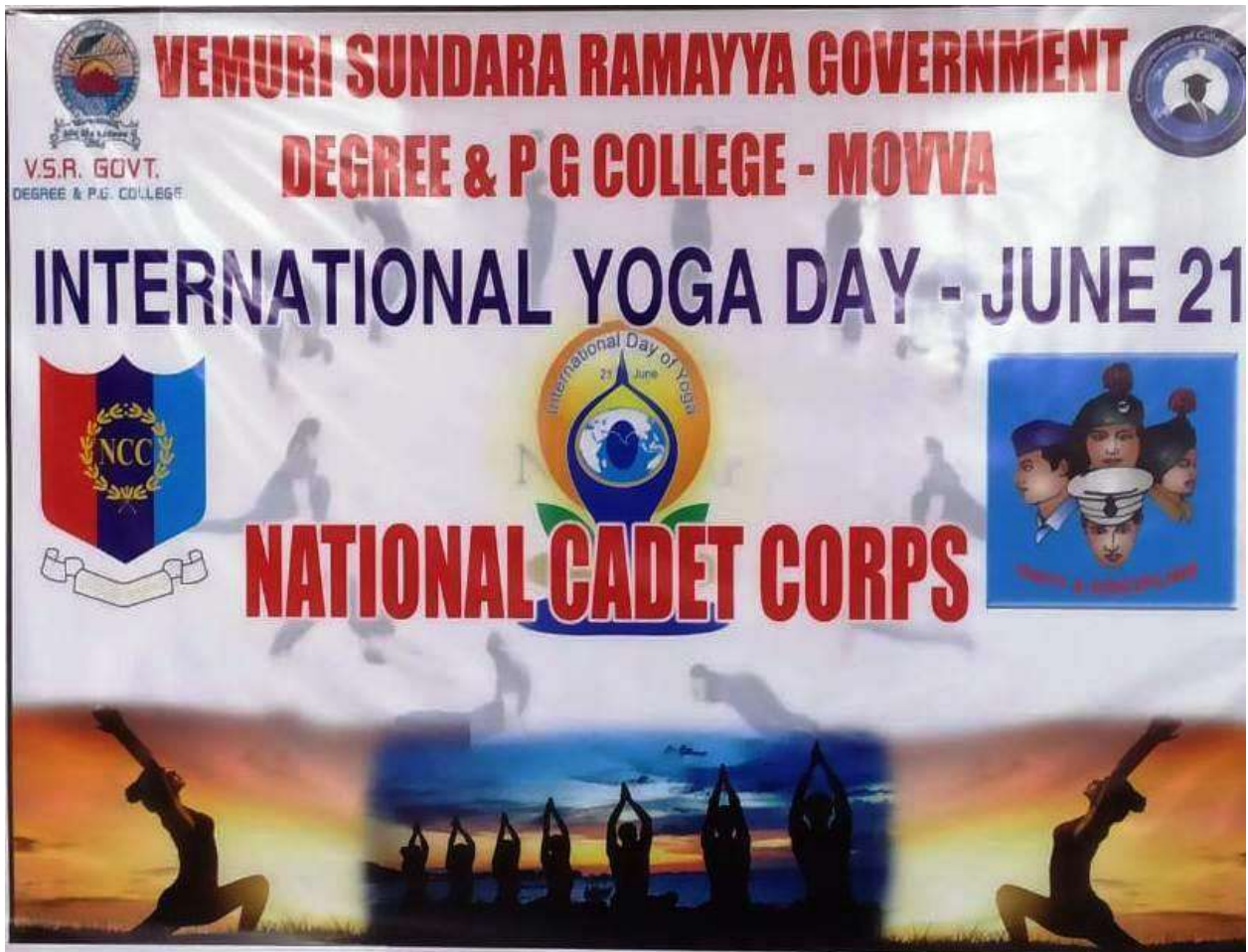
INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

our college on 15th August 2019.

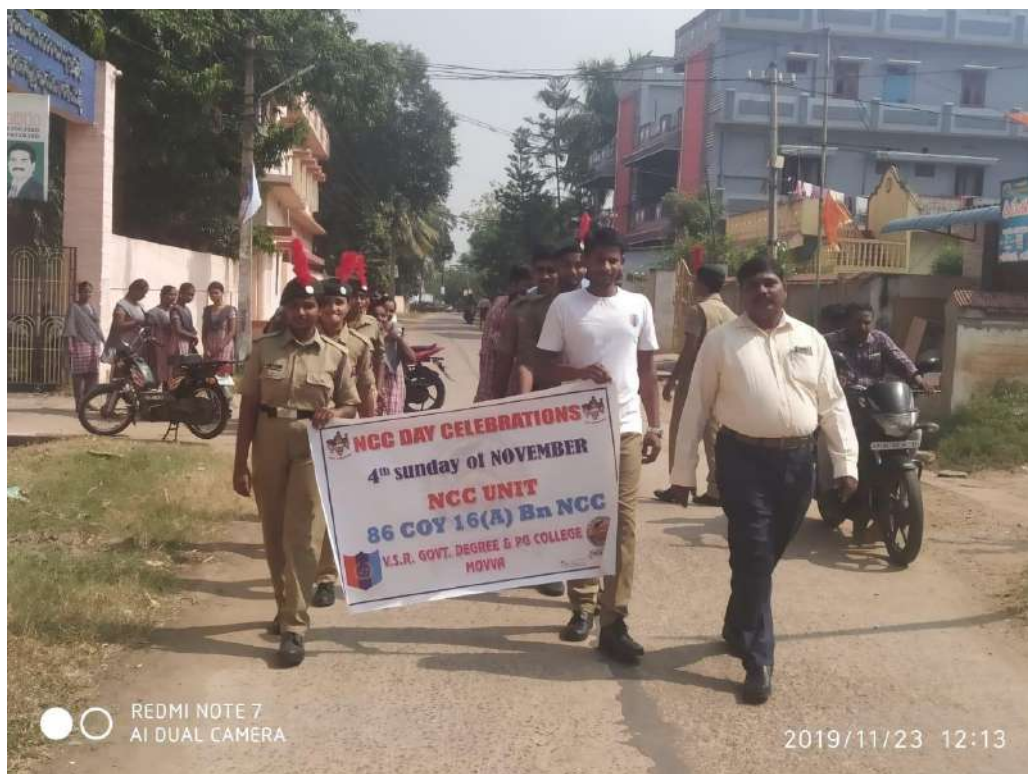
Outcome: All Cadets felt proud to be a part of Independence Day Parade, and expressed their love and respect towards the Nation.
