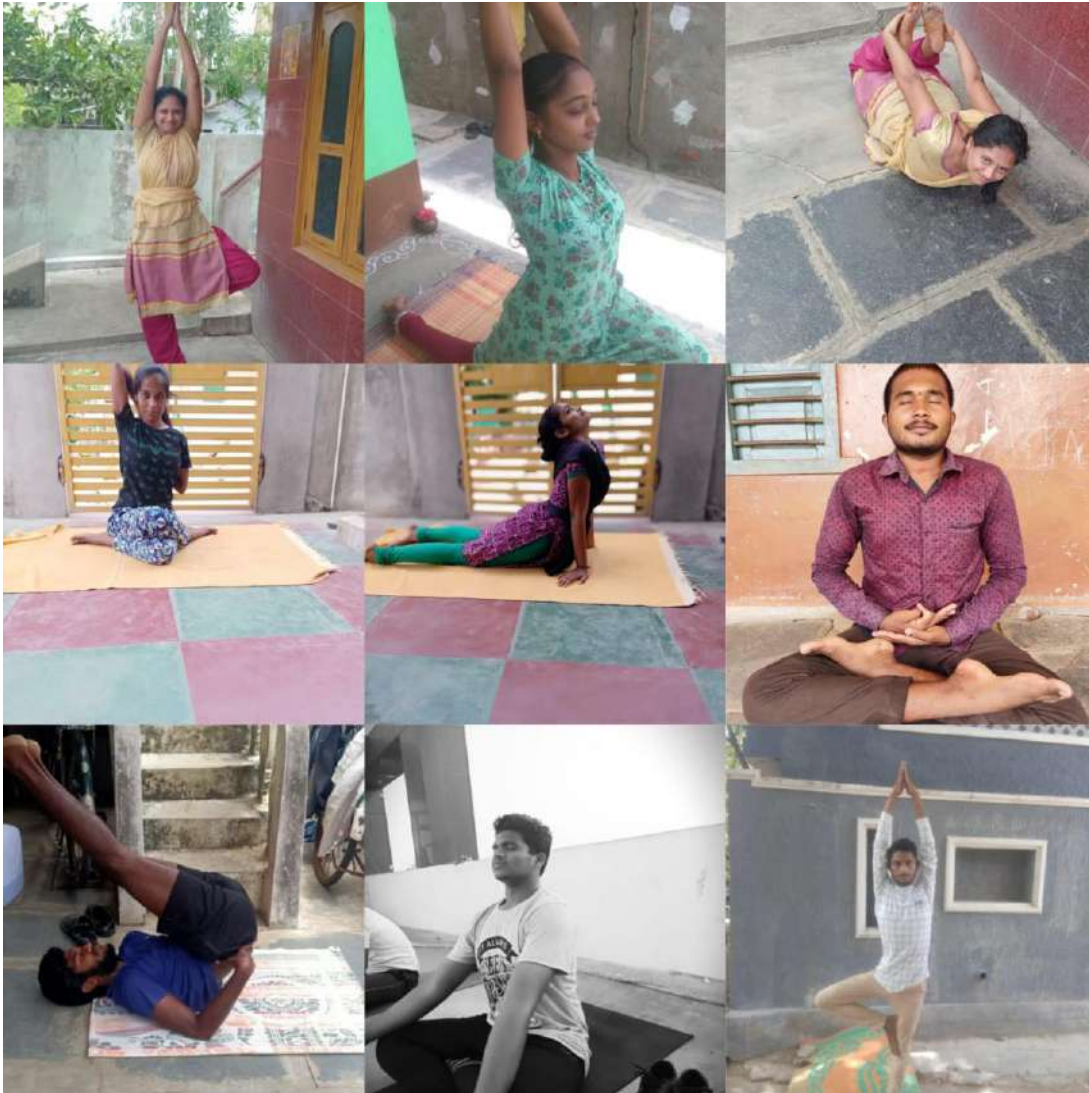

Outcome: All our cadets worked hard and felt proud for being part in such a great activity and expressed their love and respect towards college. And carry the same to the society.



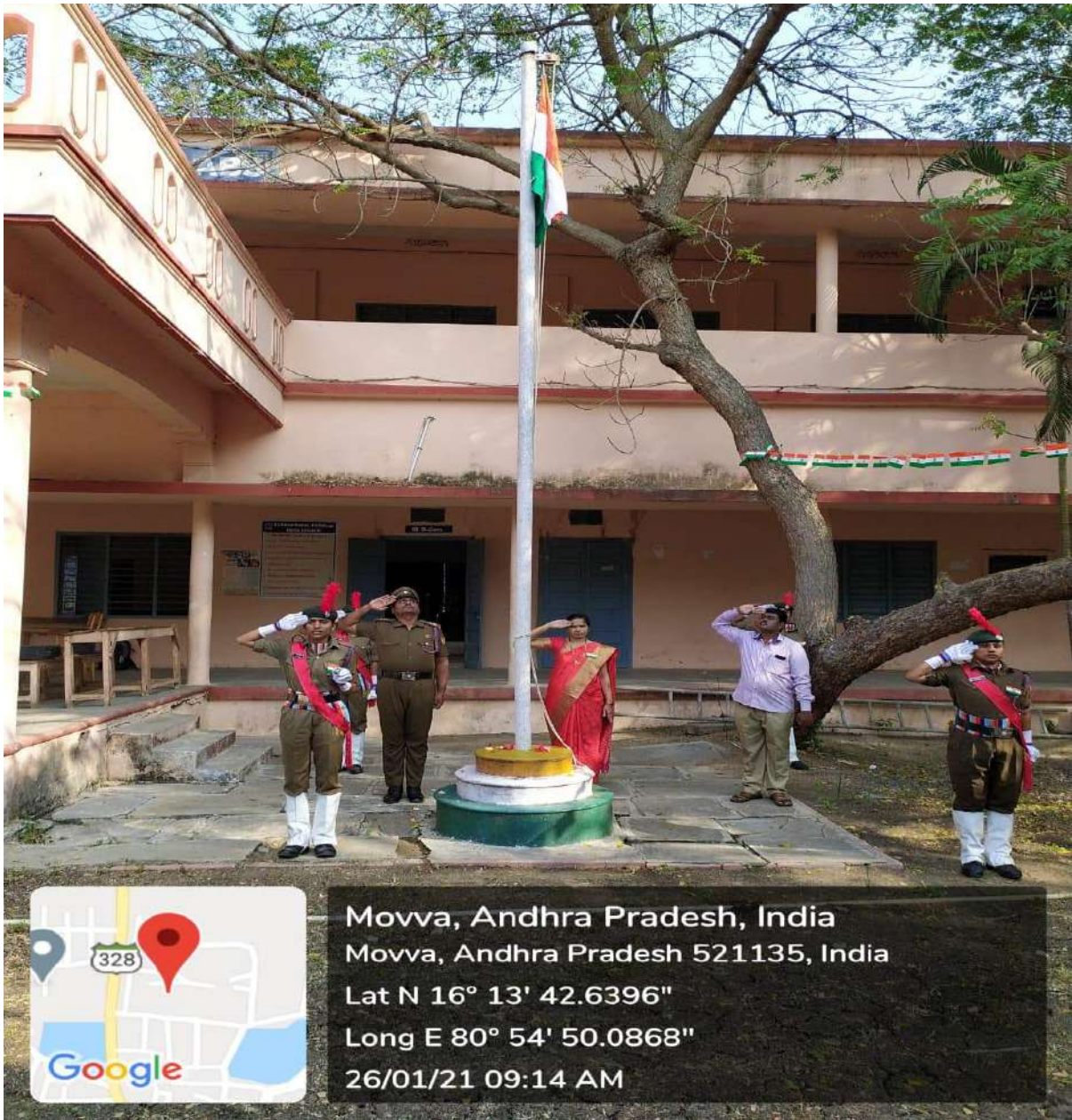
REPUBLIC DAY:
