2. EXTENSION ACTIVITIES:

As part of Society Outreach Program me, all the faculty members are involved in Socio Economic Survey, Voter Enrolment. And the like faculty conducted a number of programmers in the nearby village and interacted with the rural implementation and all these activities are recorded in Activities Register. Involved the students in conducting surveys.

WARD – COUNSELLING:

- Faculty is actively engaged in giving ward – consulting at least once in two months aiming at the overall development of the students.
- As a result of ward counselling students are feeling homely atmosphere in the college campus and class rooms.
- By ward counseling, students freely interact with the faculty and get guidance and get solutions to their problems.

STUDENTS' FEEDBACK:

- Obtaining feedback from students through appraisal forms, time to time.
- Making necessary changes in style of teaching, use of teaching – aids and class – room environment.
- Updating the departmental library with latest books, study materials and question papers of different common entrance tests and competitive exams. Like U.P.S.C., A.P.P.S.C., R.R.B., B.S.R.B., I.B.P.S., B.Ed., ICET, ANUCET etc.,

HEALTHY PRACTICES

- With regard to academic activities, we stick to the academic plan designed by the Head of the Department from the very beginning of the academic year. The Principal is assisted by the academic council to execute the academic activities, such as:
 - a) the review of the coverage of syllabus,
 - b) the diary of the staff members checked up in weekends by H.O.D.
and subsequently verified by the Principal once in a month.
 - c) the preparation of synopsis and question banks,
 - d) individual annual academic plans.
 - e) conduct of Assignments, mid Exams,
 - f) conduct of remedial classes
 - g) seminars, Quizzes, Field trips.
- The remedial classes are arranged for academically backward students
- Encouraged the students to study text books and prepare notes on their own practice. This improved the result and educational standards of students.

VALUE BASED EDUCATION

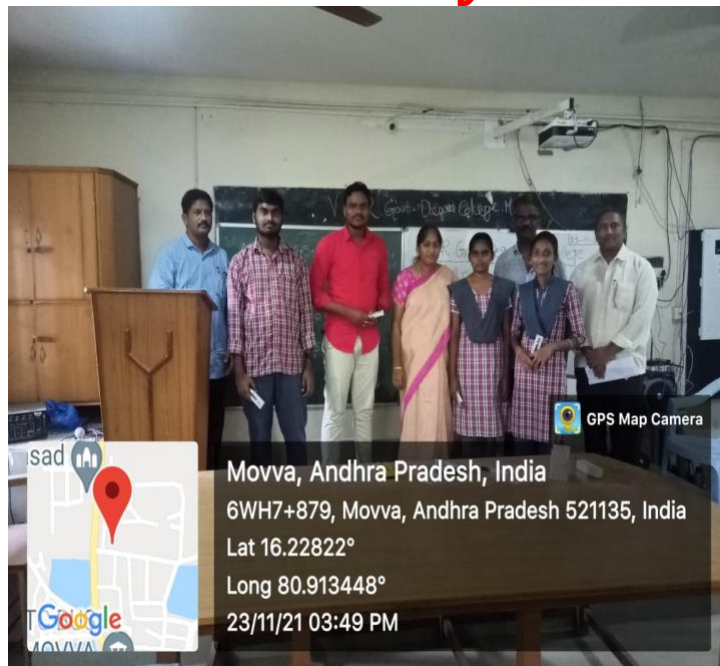
