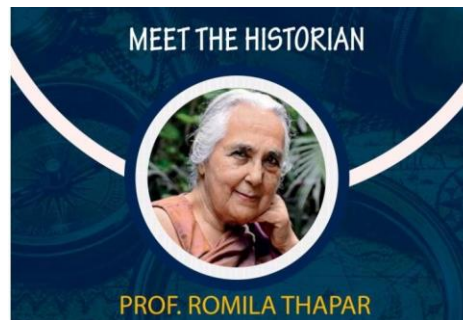
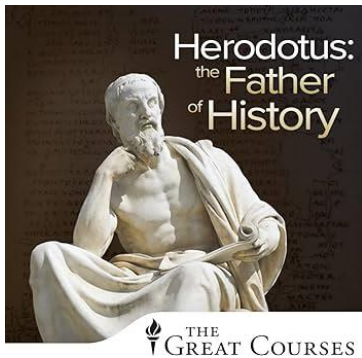

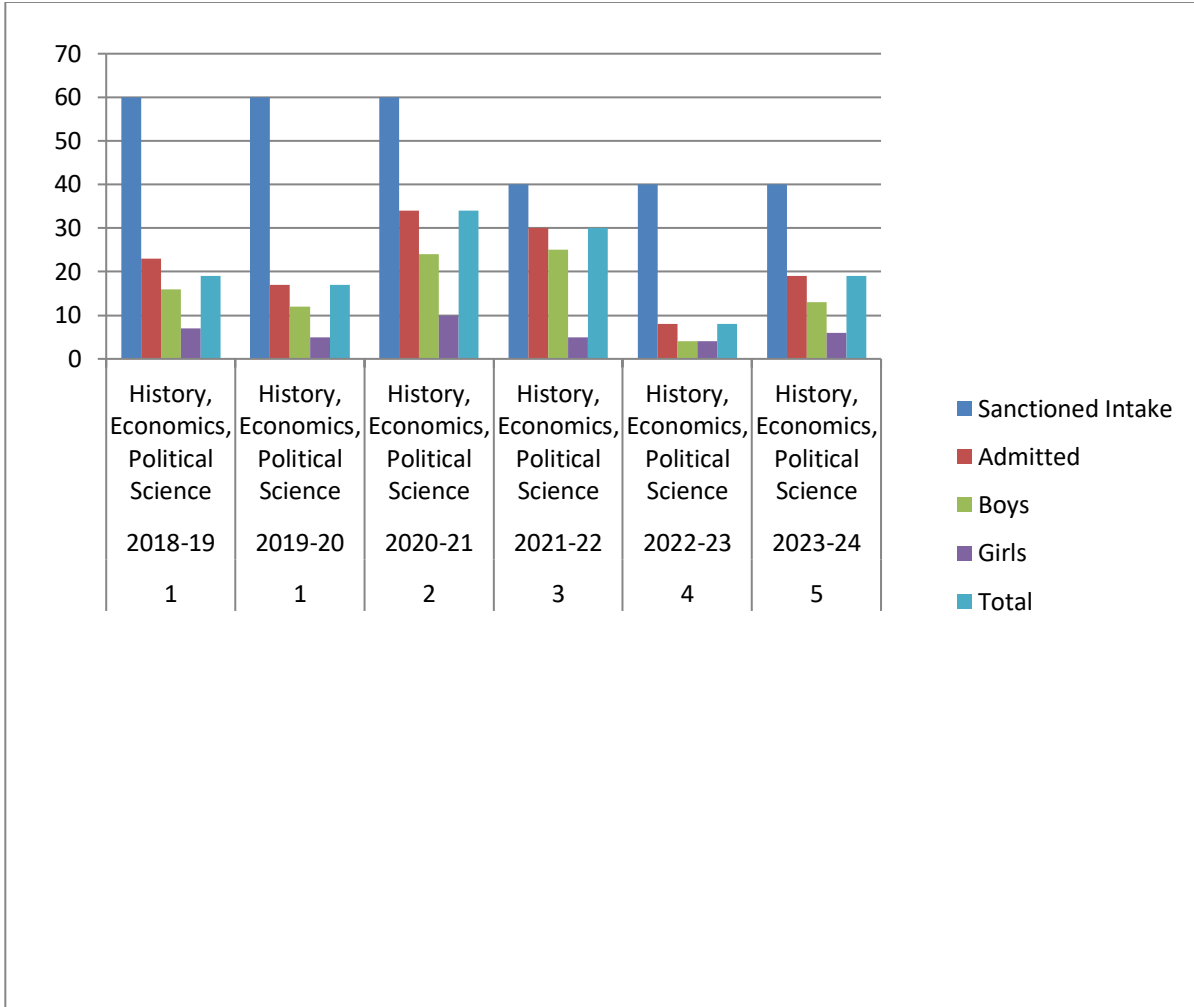
Student supporting and Progression

- Some students are selected as Teachers.

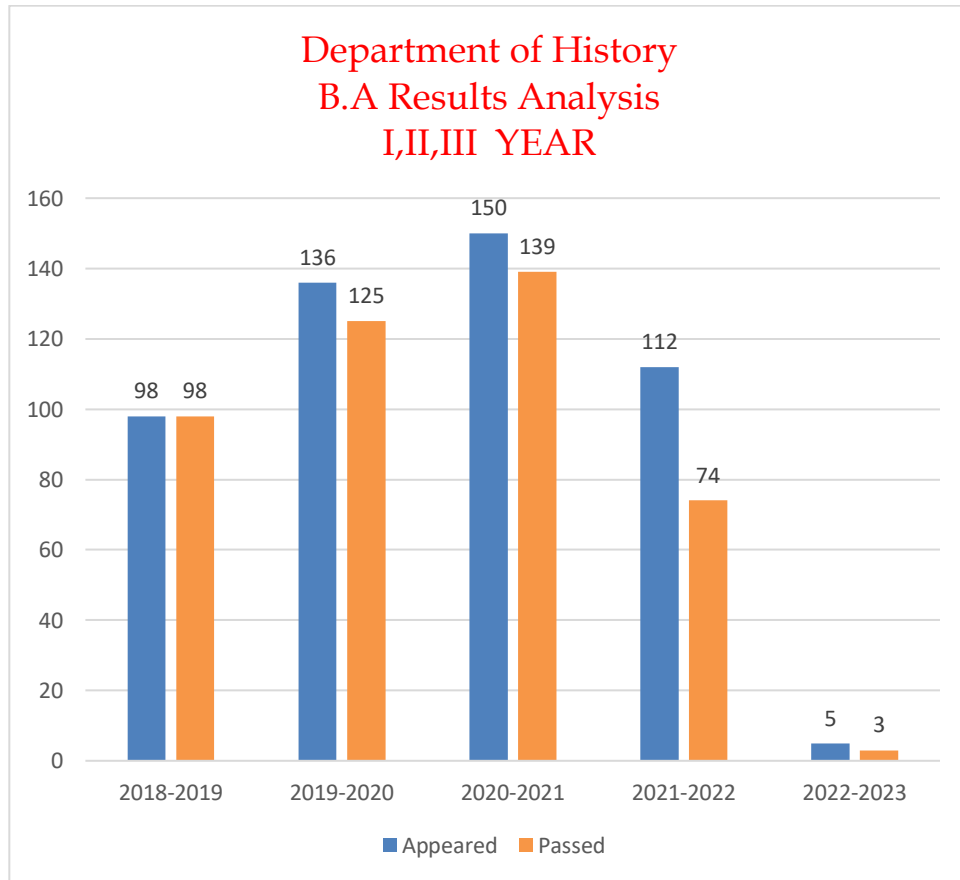
