1. Employability Skills and Emotional Intelligence

A Webinar on "Employability Skills and Emotional Intelligence" is conducted by the Dept. Of Computer Science and Jawahar Knowledge Centre, VSRGDC, Movva, on 26th May 2020 from 10a.m to 1P.m. The resource Person Dr. V. Varalakshmi enlightened the students on employability Skills, Communication and Critical thinking. She said that Employability skills are transferable skills needed by an individual to make them employable. Along with good technical understanding and subject knowledge, employers often outline a set of skills that they want from an employee. They are: critical thinking, problem solving, team work, and collaboration, professionalism and strong work, oral and written communication skills and leadership qualities. Another resource person Dr. T.Vimala, who is a Student Counsellor, Student Counselling Centre, at Acharya Nagarjuna University, Guntur spoke on Emotional Intelligence. She stressed that emotional intelligence plays a major role in Leadership. To become a self sufficient leader one needs self-awareness, self-regulation, empathy, motivation, social skills and internal motivation.

Outcome: the webinar made the students to learn the important skills like exploring different career options, gaining expert advice on careers, and achieve career maturity. Students also learn what is emotional intelligence and how to cultivate self awareness, self management, empathy etc. 385 students and staff participated in this webinar

2. Career Guidance for Interview Success:

An International Webinar on "Career Guidance for Interview Success" is organised by the Department of Computer Science and Jawahar Knowledge Centre, VSRGDC, Movva on 12th June 2020 at 9 am. The resource person is Dr. Padmini Lingaraj, A Career Coach. Addressed the students and said that Career Guidance is given to individuals to help them acquire the knowledge, information, skills and experience necessary to identify career options and make a decision regarding their career. This guidance results in their social, financial and emotional well-being throughout. An orientation is given to students for their success in interview like- practice good non-verbal communication, dress code, good communication for the interview, usage of professional language, attitude etc. 220 students and staff enthusiastically attended the webinar. **Outcome**: This webinar enlightened the students to learn and enhance their skills in communication and augment linkage of academic and career experiences to improve their career preparation and management.

3.Cyber Security:

A three day Workshop is conducted by V.S.R.G.D.C., Movva, in association with Siddhartha Institute of Engineering and Technology, Hyderabad, Sri Durga Malleswara Siddhartha Mahila Kalasala, Vijayawada, A.G.&S.G. Siddhartha Degree College of Arts and Science, Vuyyuru from 27th to 29th July 2020 from 4.30 to 6.30 pm. The resource Person S. Siva Lalitha , CEO Founder, Hypo-Techno Solutions, expressed that Cyber Security is the application of technologies, processes and controls to protect systems, networks, programs, devices and data from Cyber attack. It aims to reduce the risk of cyber attacks and protect against the unauthorised exploitation of systems and networks and technologies. She explained the types - critical infrastructure security, application security, network security, cloud security and Internet of Things (IOT) security. 150 students and staff take part in the workshop.

Outcome: The students learned that it is a great security and there is a high demand for professionals with their skills in this field. They understood that the top skills required are – problem-solving, technical aptitude, knowledge of security across various platforms, an understanding of Hacking etc.
