# CRITERION 3 NSS ACTIVITIES

### 1. <u>VANAM-MANAM</u>

A tree plantation program was organised on 24 July 2020 on the occasion of Jagananna Pacha Thoranam by the college NSS unit. The objective of this program is to achieve balanced climate and environmental protection," It focused on increasing the forest cover to 33 per cent from the existing 23 per cent by planting over 5 crore trees.
