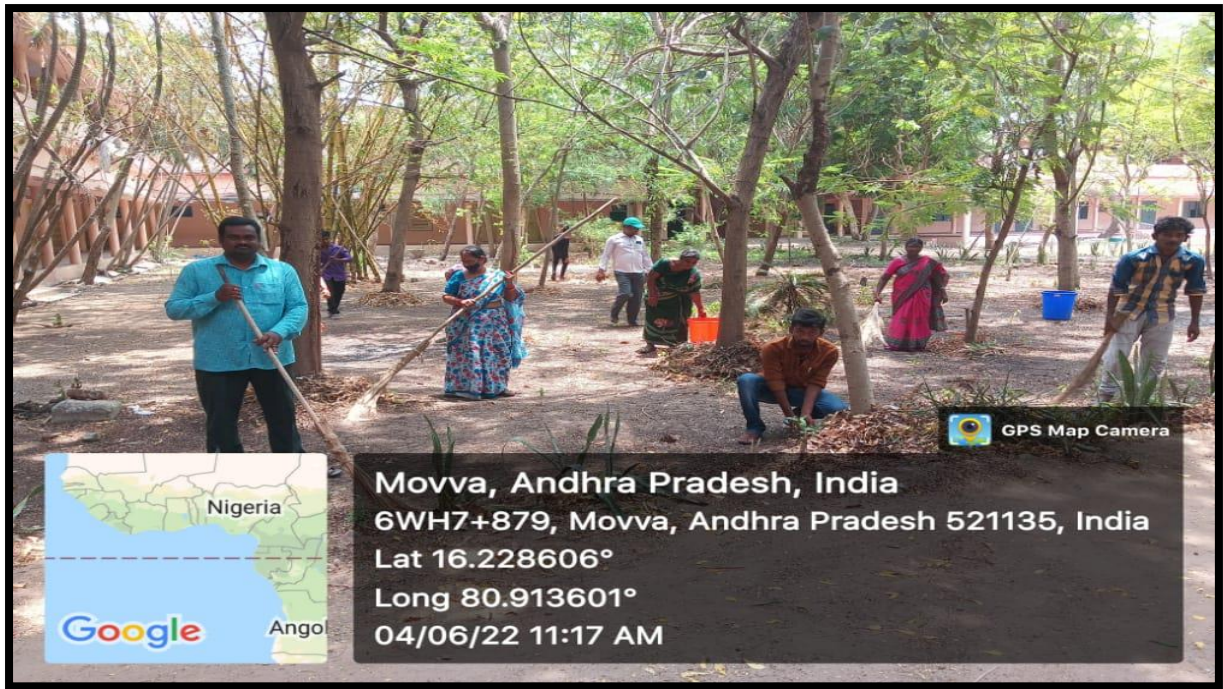


### **WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY**

- To promote healthy lifestyle choices, such as maintaining a balanced diet, engaging in regular physical activity, which can help reduce the risk of developing breast cancer.

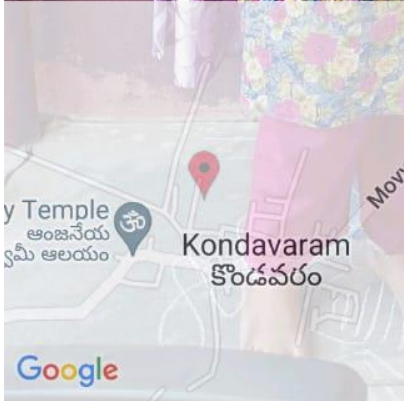
### **Outcomes:**

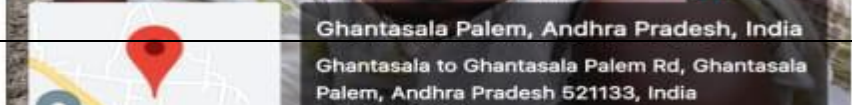

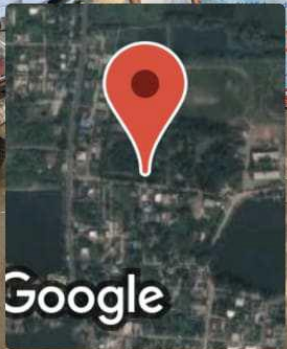
## **AIDS DAY**

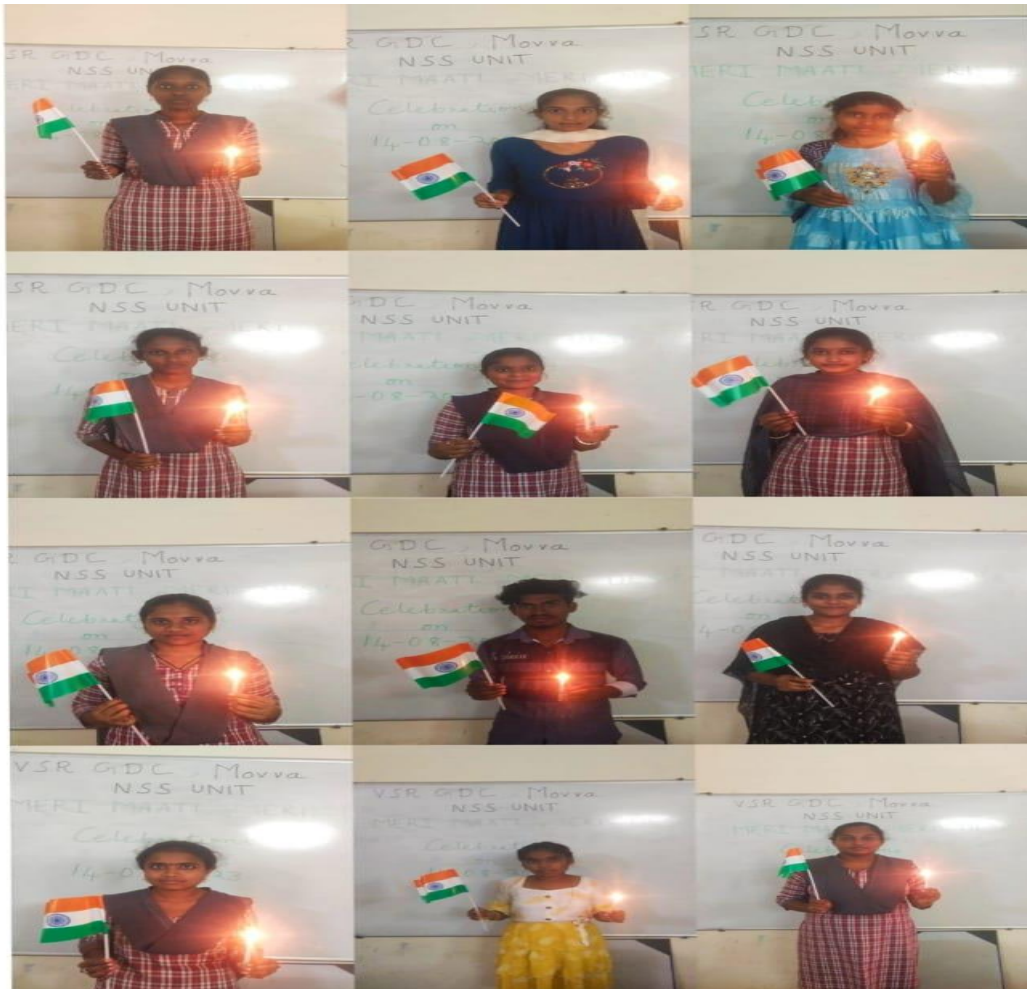
