In the reference 1st & 5th read above Government have issued orders allowing revised UGC Scales 2006 & 2016 w.e.f. 01.01.2006 & 01.01.2016 respectively to the teaching staff working in University and undergraduate Colleges in the State. In the reference 2nd read above Government have issued orders for implementation of UGC Regulations 2010 w.e.f. 30.06.2010 duly substituting the existing Appendix to G.O 1st read above. Further, in the reference 5th read above, apart from implementing UGC Scales of 2016, orders were also issued implementing UGC Regulations 2018 for awarding CAS (Career Advancement Scheme) to the Teachers, Physical Directors and Librarians.

Therefore, in pursuance of the Government orders 1st to 5th read above, a detailed Notification under CAS- January 2023 was issued in the reference 6th read above, duly incorporating the guidelines for award of all Stages (i.e., II,III,IV,V) as per UGC Regulations 2010 as amended in UGC Regulations 2016 and also for award of all Academic levels (i.e., AL -11,12,13A,14) as per UGC Regulations 2018, eligibility criteria, selection procedure under CAS were communicated to all the Government and Aided Degree Colleges in the State with directions to submit online application through specially designed web application.

Further, as per the CAS Notification January 2023 issued in the reference 6th read above, the following option has been given to individuals, for being considered for promotions under the existing Regulations to assess themselves under the PBAS system between the period from 18.07.2018 to 17.07.2021.

Option A: As per the UGC Regulations 2018.

OR

Option B: As per the UGC Regulations 2010 assessment with relaxation specified in UGC Regulations 2018 (This option can be exercised only within three years from the date of notification of 2018 regulation, i.e. within 17.7.2021). Further, it was clarified that, the Option A or B can be exercised only for the CAS due within the period of 18.07.2018 to 17.07.2021 and those who get eligibility for CAS before the date of notification of UGC Regulations 2018, i.e., 18.07.2018 shall be regulated by UGC regulations 2010 and its subsequent regulations.

In the reference 8th read above, Screening cum Evaluation and Selection Committees constituted for awarding various stages and Academic levels to the Lecturers were convened from 19.06.2023 to 29.06.2023 and also the incumbents who have applied for Stage VI & V , Academic Level 13 A & 14 have attended interviews for the selections. The said Selection Committees have finalized the list of eligible and ineligible Lecturers for the said promotions.

Therefore, in pursuance of the minutes of the Screening cum Evaluation and Selection Committees the following promotion under CAS is hereby ordered :-

The above promotion under CAS is subject to the condition that:

i. The re-designation of the Lecturers as Assistant Professors/ Associate Professors / Professors will be issued separately.

ii. The lecturers who are now allowed 10000/- AGP (Stage - V) / Academic Level 13A & Academic Level 14 cannot claim the post of Principal just because they are allowed the 10000/- AGP / Academic Level 13A & Academic Level 14.

iii. If the Stage/ Academic levels now allowed is found irregular at a later date the same will be reviewed and revised as per rules besides recovery of the amount accrued due to fixation of pay based on the date now awarded from the individual concerned without assigning any notice to the individual besides recovery of the amount.

The Principals of Government Degree Colleges and Correspondents of Aided Degree Colleges in the State are requested to communicate the orders to the individuals concerned under proper acknowledgement and submit proposals for fixation of pay in respect of the individual to the Regional Joint Director of Collegiate Education concerned strictly following the date so awarded in this proceedings.

The original Service Registers of the individuals received in the office for this purpose will be returned to the respective college through the Regional Joint Directors of the Collegiate Education concerned. Necessary entries have to be recorded in the Service Register of the individual under proper attestation.
