


Dr. B.R Ambedkar Death Anniversary (06-12-2021)

PI DAY CELEBRATION

March 14 is a day to celebrate the mathematical constant. Every March 14, mathematicians, scientists and math lovers around the world celebrate 'Pi' Day, a commemoration of the mathematical sign Pi. It's the only holiday to honour a number: pi on 3.14, the beginning digits of the infinite, on repeating decimal expansion of $\Pi = 3.1415926$.



As the ratio of a circle circumference to its diameter, Π is irrational and transcendental qualities sure to bring a twinkle to any mathematician's eyes. The Department of Mathematics in association with IQAC of our college celebrated 'Pi' Day on 14th March 2022. Total 50 students participated in this programme. The department of Mathematics initiative to observe PI day is to motivate, encourage the students of mathematics so that they get to realize the importance of the subject and the concept of PI amongst the students. "It's a fun way to enjoy math", Pi has been calculated to over one trillion digits beyond its decimal point. As an irrational and transcendental number, it will continue infinitely without repetition or pattern. While only a handful of

digits are needed for typical calculations, Pi's infinite nature makes it a fun challenge to memorize, and to computationally calculate more and more digits.



Speaking on this occasion our In-charge Principal Smt. K. R. Manjula said that the importance of mathematics is not only crucial for scientists or engineers, but it helps develop skills, such as analyzing data, seeking evidence, recognizing patterns every day. It gives a chance to people have a better way of understanding or interpreting information. Sri. Surya Kumar, Lecturer in Mathematics, elaborated on the concept of Pi and its significance to resolve mathematical problems. He had remained the students that since the Pi are an irrational number and its complete value cannot be obtained, super computers are being used by the mathematics scholars to calculate the infinite numbers implied in the concept of Pi.

For those who need a refresher, the holiday commemorates not only the 16th letter in the Greek alphabet
- Π-used in mathematics to represent the ratio of the circumference of a circle to its diameter, but also Albert
Einstein's Birthday. So, let's all take a second to appreciate this coincidence.
